### **Participant Spotlight - Beats for Soul**

**Beats for Soul** is a music therapy program created by two TCNJ Bonner Community Scholars, Jessica Damanski and Simranjot Mann, that aims to connect our participants with dementia to their love of music.

It has been shown that music is associated with reduced anxiety, pain, and blood pressure. For people with dementia, the regions of the brain that encode memories related to music are some of the last to be affected by the disease. Therefore, music can reduce agitation and anxiety in both the patient and caregiver. Seeing this as an opportunity, Jessica and Simran collected information about the music preferences of five Meals on Wheels participants with dementia and created a music playlist for each person. They downloaded the playlists onto MP3 players and distributed them to the participants in late

October.

The response to the Beats for Soul program has been very positive. Caregivers have expressed their gratitude and said that their loved ones really enjoy the music. The success of this program speaks to the healing and unifying power of music.
